The Food Distribution Program is a federally funded program through USDA that provides commodity foods to low income American Indians and non-Indian households residing on a reservation and to households living in approved areas near a reservation that contains at least one person who is a member of a federally recognized tribe.

The areas served by the Acoma Food Distribution Program include Acoma and Laguna reservations, and/or nearby towns of Grants, Milan, San Rafael, San Fidel, Cubero, and Seboyeta.

- Eligible households are certified based upon income and resource standards set by the federal government.
- Each month, participating households receive a food package to help them maintain a nutritionally balanced diet.

The Haak'u Learning Center Child Care Program is designed in part to provide monetary help to low-income families who are in need of Quality Child Care Services. The Program provides childcare services for the families of our community. The program has a Center Base infant and toddler room which provides services for sixteen (16) children. The ages range from 6 weeks to 3 years old. The program also has In-Home Child Care service which is for parents who may prefer a relative to sign-up as an in-home provider in order to watch their children.

The Head Start Program provides developmentally appropriate services for children ages 3 to 5 and their families. The program also provides services to children ages 2½to 3 who have an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP).
